- 1 AN ACT Relating to authorizing removal of motor vehicles bought or
- 2 received in pledge by a pawnbroker from the pawnbroker's place of
- 3 business; and amending RCW 19.60.050.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.60.050 and 1991 c 323 s 5 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Property bought or received in pledge by any pawnbroker shall not
- 8 be removed from that place of business, except when redeemed by, or
- 9 returned to the owner, within thirty days after the receipt of the
- 10 property. However, a motor vehicle bought or received in pledge may be
- 11 removed from the pawnbroker's place of business to a secured location
- 12 <u>if the owner of the vehicle consents to the removal in writing.</u>
- 13 Property shall at all times during the ordinary hours of business be
- 14 open to inspection to any commissioned law enforcement officer of the
- 15 state or any of its political subdivisions.
