- 1 AN ACT Relating to health care facility worker identification; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 70.41 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.41 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 All persons employed by, working for, volunteering with,
- 7 contracting with, leasing space from, or otherwise providing services
- 8 at a health care facility shall wear an identification badge. The
- 9 badge must be worn on the person's clothing so that it is visible and
- 10 readable. The badge must include the person's name and job title,
- 11 position, or role at the health care facility. For the purposes of
- 12 this section, "health care facility" means a facility that provides
- 13 health related services, including but not limited to, a hospital,
- 14 clinic, pharmacy, health care provider's office, health maintenance
- 15 organization, diagnostic or treatment center, neuropsychiatric or
- 16 mental health facility, or long-term care facility required to be
- 17 licensed under chapter 18.20, 18.51, 72.36, or 70.128 RCW or a home
- 18 health, hospice, or home care agency licensed under chapter 70.127, or
- 19 contracted assisted living services pursuant to RCW 74.39A.010. For

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- 1 the purposes of this section "person" includes but is not limited to
- 2 health care provider, staff member, and all other employees, both
- 3 professional and nonprofessional, as well as volunteers.
- 4 The health care facility owner or his or her designee is
- 5 responsible for assuring that all persons comply with this section.

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
