- 1 AN ACT Relating to affirming and clarifying the legislative
- 2 authority to treat nonmedicaid therapy costs as unallowable, insuring
- 3 that for medical care recipients, only therapy costs, that are not
- 4 covered by other payers, may be reimbursed in the per patient day rate;
- 5 amending RCW 74.46.190; and declaring an emergency.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.46.190 and 1983 1st ex.s. c 67 s 12 are each 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (1) The substance of a transaction will prevail over its form.
- 10 (2) All documented costs which are ordinary, necessary, related to
- 11 care of medical care recipients, and not expressly unallowable, are to
- 12 be allowable. Costs of providing ancillary care are allowable, subject
- 13 to any applicable cost center limit contained in this chapter, provided
- 14 <u>documentation establishes the costs were incurred for medical care</u>
- 15 recipients and other sources of payment to which recipients may be
- 16 legally entitled, such as private insurance or medicare, were first
- 17 <u>fully utilized</u>.
- 18 (3) Costs applicable to services, facilities, and supplies
- 19 furnished to the provider by related organizations are allowable but at

- 1 the cost to the related organization, provided they do not exceed the
- 2 price of comparable services, facilities, or supplies that could be
- 3 purchased elsewhere.
- 4 (4) Beginning January 1, 1985, the payment for property usage is to
- 5 be independent of ownership structure and financing arrangements.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 7 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 8 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 9 effect immediately.
