- 1 AN ACT Relating to traffic deaths caused by falling asleep at the
- 2 wheel; reenacting and amending RCW 46.63.020; adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 46.61 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) When the death of any person ensues within three years as a
- 8 proximate result of injury proximately caused by the driving of any
- 9 vehicle by any person, the driver is guilty of sleeping-driver homicide
- 10 if, under circumstances not constituting vehicular homicide, the
- 11 driver: (a) Fell asleep while operating a motor vehicle; and (b) the
- 12 circumstances leading up to the accident would have indicated to a
- 13 reasonable person that he or she was likely to fall asleep at the
- 14 wheel.
- 15 (2) Sleeping-driver homicide is a gross misdemeanor punishable
- 16 under chapter 9A.20 RCW.
