- AN ACT Relating to prostitution; amending RCW 9A.88.030, 9A.88.090,
- 2 and 9A.88.110; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.88.030 and 1988 c 145 s 16 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A person is guilty of prostitution if such person engages or 7 agrees or offers to engage in sexual conduct with another person in 8 return for a fee.
- 9 (2) For purposes of this section, "sexual conduct" means "sexual 10 intercourse" or "sexual contact," both as defined in chapter 9A.44 RCW.
- 11 (3) Prostitution is a misdemeanor <u>except that a third or subsequent</u> 12 offense within five years is a gross misdemeanor.
- 13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9A.88.090 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.88.090 are 14 each amended to read as follows:
- 15 (1) A person is guilty of permitting prostitution if, having
- 16 possession or control of premises which he or she knows are being used
- 17 for prostitution purposes, he or she fails without lawful excuse to
- 18 make reasonable effort to halt or abate such use.

- 1 (2) Permitting prostitution is a misdemeanor <u>except that a third or</u> 2 subsequent offense within five years is a gross misdemeanor.
- 3 **Sec. 3.** RCW 9A.88.110 and 1988 c 146 s 4 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
 - (1) A person is guilty of patronizing a prostitute if:

- 6 (a) Pursuant to a prior understanding, he or she pays a fee to 7 another person as compensation for such person or a third person having 8 engaged in sexual conduct with him or her; or
- 9 (b) He or she pays or agrees to pay a fee to another person 10 pursuant to an understanding that in return therefor such person will 11 engage in sexual conduct with him or her; or
- 12 (c) He or she solicits or requests another person to engage in 13 sexual conduct with him or her in return for a fee.
- 14 (2) For purposes of this section, "sexual conduct" has the meaning 15 given in RCW 9A.88.030.
- 16 (3) Patronizing a prostitute is a misdemeanor <u>except that a third</u>
 17 <u>or subsequent offense within five years is a gross misdemeanor</u>.
