- 1 AN ACT Relating to transport tags for game; and amending RCW 2 77.32.320.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.320 and 1990 c 84 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) In addition to a basic hunting license, a separate transport
- 7 tag is required to hunt deer, elk, bear, cougar, sheep, mountain goat,
- 8 moose, or wild turkey. The commission may authorize the purchase of
- 9 cougar transport tags subsequent to harvest and stipulate conditions
- 10 for their validation and use.
- 11 (2) A transport tag may only be obtained subsequent to the purchase
- 12 of a valid hunting license and must have permanently affixed to it the
- 13 hunting license number or as required by the commission under
- 14 <u>subsection (1) of this section</u>.
- 15 (3) Persons who kill deer, elk, bear, cougar, mountain goat, sheep,
- 16 moose, or wild turkey shall immediately validate and attach their own
- 17 transport tag to the carcass as provided by rule of the director.
