Any other school district shall be a school district of the second class.
- Whenever the educational service district superintendent finds that 12 13 the classification of a school district should be changed, and upon the 14 approval of the superintendent of public instruction, he or she shall 15 make an order in conformity with his or her findings and alter the records of his or her office accordingly. Thereafter the board of 16 17 directors of the district shall organize in the manner provided by law
