- 1 AN ACT Relating to insurance coverage for hazardous waste cleanups;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 48.05 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.05 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Where an insurer has provided liability coverage for bodily
 7 injury or property damage caused by a release of hazardous substances
 8 and that coverage potentially would be available to compensate a third
 9 party or other entity, then that third party or other entity has a
 10 direct cause of action against the insurer.
- (2) Where an insurer has provided liability coverage for bodily 11 12 injury or property damage caused by a release of hazardous substances 13 and, but for a petition for relief granted under the bankruptcy code, 14 the dissolution of a corporation, limited liability corporation, 15 partnership or limited partnership, or death of a person, that coverage 16 potentially would be available to compensate a third party or other 17 entity, then that third party or other entity has a direct cause of action against the insurer of the debtor, dissolved corporation, 18 limited liability corporation, partnership or limited partnership, or 19

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- 1 deceased person. Nothing in this section may be interpreted to give
- 2 rise to a cause of action against the bankrupt shareholders of a
- 3 dissolved corporation or heirs of a deceased person.

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
