- 1 AN ACT Relating to business and occupation tax credits for
- 2 educational expenses at private K-12 schools; adding a new section to
- 3 chapter 82.04 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 In computing the tax imposed under this chapter, a credit is
- 8 allowed against the amount of tax otherwise due under this chapter
- 9 equal to fifty percent of any amounts paid during the reporting period
- 10 for educational expenses of students incurred in attending private K-12
- 11 schools, subject to the following limitations:
- 12 (1) No credit may be taken in excess of two percent of the tax
- 13 liability for the reporting period; and
- 14 (2) No credit may carry over to a subsequent reporting period.
- 15 As used in this section, "educational expenses" means tuition
- 16 expenses and expenses for books and materials.
