## SENATE BILL 6341

State of Washington 54th Legislature 1996 Regular Session

**By** Senators Fairley, Deccio and Wojahn; by request of Department of Health

Read first time 01/11/96. Referred to Committee on Health & Long-Term Care.

AN ACT Relating to registration of adult family home providers and resident managers; amending RCW 70.128.120, 18.48.010, and 18.48.020; reenacting and amending RCW 18.130.040; adding a new section to chapter 18.48 RCW; and providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 Sec. 1. RCW 70.128.120 and 1995 1st sp.s. c 18 s 117 are each 7 amended to read as follows:

8 ((An)) <u>Each</u> adult family home provider <u>and each resident manager</u>
9 shall have the following minimum qualifications:

10 (1) Twenty-one years of age or older;

11 (2) Good moral and responsible character and reputation;

12 (3) Literacy;

13 (4) Management and administrative ability to carry out the 14 requirements of this chapter;

(5) Satisfactory completion of department-approved initial training
and continuing education training as specified by the department in
rule;

(6) Satisfactory completion of department-approved, or equivalent,
 special care training before a provider may provide special care
 services to a resident;

4 (7) Not been convicted of any crime listed in RCW 43.43.830 and 5 43.43.842; and

6 (8) Effective July 1, 1996, registered with the department of 7 health.

8 **Sec. 2.** RCW 18.48.010 and 1995 c 260 s 7 are each amended to read 9 as follows:

10 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in 11 this section apply throughout this chapter.

12 (1) "Secretary" means the secretary of the department of health.

(2) "Adult family home" means a regular family abode of a person or persons who provide personal care, special care, room, and board to more than one but not more than six adults who are not related by blood or marriage to the person or persons providing the services.

17 (3) (("Operator" means a provider who is licensed under chapter 18 70.128 RCW to operate an adult family home.

19 (4) "Person" includes an individual, firm, corporation, 20 partnership, or association)) "Resident manager" means a person who is 21 employed or otherwise is contracted with by the provider to manage the 22 adult family home.

(4) "Provider" means any person who is licensed under chapter
 70.128 RCW to operate an adult family home. For the purposes of this
 section, "person" means any individual, partnership, corporation,
 association, or limited liability company.

27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 18.48 RCW 28 to read as follows:

29 A provider who operates more than one adult family home must 30 register for each separate location.

31 **Sec. 4.** RCW 18.48.020 and 1995 c 260 s 8 are each amended to read 32 as follows:

33 ((A person who operates an adult family home shall register the 34 home with the secretary. Each separate location of the business of an 35 adult family home shall have a separate registration.)) (1) The

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1 secretary shall register adult family home providers and resident
2 managers.

3 (2) The secretary, by policy or rule, shall <u>define terms and</u> 4 establish forms and procedures for ((the processing of operator)) 5 registration applications, including the payment of registration fees 6 pursuant to RCW 43.70.250. An application for an adult family home 7 ((operator)) resident manager or provider registration shall include at 8 least the following information:

9 (((<del>1)</del>)) <u>(a)</u> ((The names and addresses of the operator of the adult 10 family home)) <u>Name and address</u>; and

11 (((2))) (b) If the ((operator)) provider is a corporation, copies 12 of its articles of incorporation and current bylaws, together with the 13 names and addresses of its officers and directors.

14 ((A registration issued by the secretary in accordance with this 15 section shall remain effective for a period of one year from the date 16 of its issuance unless the registration is revoked or suspended 17 pursuant to RCW 18.48.030, or unless))

18 (3) The secretary shall adopt policies or rules to establish the 19 registration periods, fees, and procedures. If the adult family home 20 is sold or ownership or management is transferred, ((in which case)) 21 the registration ((of the home)) shall be voided and the ((operator)) 22 provider and resident manager shall apply for a new registration.

Sec. 5. RCW 18.130.040 and 1995 c 336 s 2, 1995 c 323 s 16, 1995 c 260 s 11, and 1995 c 1 s 19 (Initiative Measure No. 607) are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

(1) This chapter applies only to the secretary and the boards and commissions having jurisdiction in relation to the professions licensed under the chapters specified in this section. This chapter does not apply to any business or profession not licensed under the chapters specified in this section.

31 (2)(a) The secretary has authority under this chapter in relation 32 to the following professions:

33 (i) Dispensing opticians licensed under chapter 18.34 RCW;

34 (ii) Naturopaths licensed under chapter 18.36A RCW;

35 (iii) Midwives licensed under chapter 18.50 RCW;

36 (iv) Ocularists licensed under chapter 18.55 RCW;

37 (v) Massage operators and businesses licensed under chapter 18.10838 RCW;

(vi) Dental hygienists licensed under chapter 18.29 RCW; 1 (vii) Acupuncturists licensed under chapter 18.06 RCW; 2 (viii) Radiologic technologists certified and x-ray technicians 3 4 registered under chapter 18.84 RCW; 5 (ix) Respiratory care practitioners certified under chapter 18.89 RCW; б 7 (x) Persons registered or certified under chapter 18.19 RCW; 8 (xi) Persons registered as nursing pool operators under chapter 9 18.52C RCW; 10 (xii) Nursing assistants registered or certified under chapter 18.79 RCW; 11 (xiii) Health care assistants certified under chapter 18.135 RCW; 12 13 (xiv) Dietitians and nutritionists certified under chapter 18.138 14 RCW; 15 (xv) Sex offender treatment providers certified under chapter 18.155 RCW; 16 17 (xvi) Persons licensed and certified under chapter 18.73 RCW or RCW 18.71.205; 18 19 (xvii) Persons registered as adult family home ((operators)) providers and resident managers under RCW 18.48.020; and 20 (xviii) Denturists licensed under chapter 18.30 RCW. 21 22 (b) The boards and commissions having authority under this chapter 23 are as follows: 24 (i) The podiatric medical board as established in chapter 18.22 25 RCW; 26 (ii) The chiropractic quality assurance commission as established 27 in chapter 18.25 RCW; (iii) The dental quality assurance commission as established in 28 chapter 18.32 RCW; 29 30 (iv) The board on fitting and dispensing of hearing aids as established in chapter 18.35 RCW; 31 (v) The board of examiners for nursing home administrators as 32 established in chapter 18.52 RCW; 33 34 (vi) The optometry board as established in chapter 18.54 RCW governing licenses issued under chapter 18.53 RCW; 35 (vii) The board of osteopathic medicine and surgery as established 36 37 in chapter 18.57 RCW governing licenses issued under chapters 18.57 and 18.57A RCW; 38

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(viii) The board of pharmacy as established in chapter 18.64 RCW
 governing licenses issued under chapters 18.64 and 18.64A RCW;

3 (ix) The medical quality assurance commission as established in 4 chapter 18.71 RCW governing licenses and registrations issued under 5 chapters 18.71 and 18.71A RCW;

6 (x) The board of physical therapy as established in chapter 18.74 7 RCW;

8 (xi) The board of occupational therapy practice as established in 9 chapter 18.59 RCW;

10 (xii) The nursing care quality assurance commission as established
 11 in chapter 18.79 RCW governing licenses issued under that chapter;

12 (xiii) The examining board of psychology and its disciplinary 13 committee as established in chapter 18.83 RCW; and

14 (xiv) The veterinary board of governors as established in chapter15 18.92 RCW.

(3) In addition to the authority to discipline license holders, the 16 disciplining authority has the authority to grant or deny licenses 17 based on the conditions and criteria established in this chapter and 18 19 the chapters specified in subsection (2) of this section. This chapter also governs any investigation, hearing, or proceeding relating to 20 denial of licensure or issuance of a license conditioned on the 21 applicant's compliance with an order entered pursuant to RCW 18.130.160 22 23 by the disciplining authority.

(4) All disciplining authorities shall adopt procedures to ensure
substantially consistent application of this chapter, the uniform
disciplinary act, among the disciplining authorities listed in
subsection (2) of this section.

28 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1996.

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
