- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.150
- 5 RCW to read as follows:

State of Washington

- 6 The legislature finds that parents have the primary responsibility
- 7 for the welfare of their children. The successful education of these
- 8 children is the product of a responsive and rigorous educational system
- 9 that depends on the participation of informed and concerned parents.
- 10 Each school district shall send a letter to every parent of a
- 11 student in the district inviting the parents to inspect and review all
- 12 curriculum materials. The letter shall inform parents that it is their
- 13 right to do so.
- 14 Two times a year, each school shall convene an evening meeting to
- 15 allow parents to inspect and review the curriculum materials being
- 16 used.
- 17 Parents may immediately seek an injunction in court if the
- 18 curriculum violates state or federal laws, rules, or regulations.
- 19 Districts shall pay attorneys' fees if a parent prevails. If the

- 1 district violates the injunction it shall be fined one thousand dollars
- 2 per day for each violation.
