(ii) In a city with a population of one hundred thousand or more but less than four hundred thousand, upon the filing of a petition which is sufficient as determined by RCW 35A.01.040 requesting the exclusion from the boundaries of the city of an area containing at least forty percent of the qualified voters of the city described by metes and bounds or by reference to a recorded plat or government survey, signed by qualified voters of the area proposed to be excluded equal in number to not less than twenty-five percent of the number of voters of the area proposed to be excluded voting at the last general municipal election, the city legislative body shall submit the issue of reduction of city limits to the voters of the area proposed to be excluded;

(iii) In a city with a population of ten thousand or more but less than one hundred thousand, upon the filing of a petition which is sufficient as determined by RCW 35A.01.040 requesting the exclusion from the boundaries of the city of an area containing at least fifty percent of the qualified voters of the city described by metes and bounds or by reference to a recorded plat or government survey, signed by qualified voters of the area proposed to be excluded equal in number to not less than twenty-five percent of the number of voters of the area proposed to be excluded voting at the last general municipal election, the city legislative body shall submit the issue of reduction of city limits to the voters of the area proposed to be excluded.

(2) The question shall be submitted at the next general municipal election if one is to be held within one hundred eighty days or at a special election called for that purpose not less than ninety days nor more than one hundred eighty days after the certification of sufficiency of the petition or the passage of the resolution. The petition or resolution shall set out and describe the territory to be
