- 1 AN ACT Relating to the release of addicted infants from hospitals;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 18.71 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.71 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Except as provided under this section, it is unlawful for a
- 7 physician to discharge from a hospital or other health care facility,
- 8 any infant who must be put on a controlled substance in order to be
- 9 detoxified as a result of his or her mother's prenatal drug use. A
- 10 physician may discharge such an infant to a facility that provides
- 11 twenty-four-hour per day medical supervision or keep the infant in the
- 12 hospital, until the infant has completed the withdrawal process and no
- 13 longer requires a controlled substance for treatment.
