- 1 AN ACT Relating to deterring the unwarranted or abusive use of the
- 2 offender grievance process; and adding a new section to chapter 72.09
- 3 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.09 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 To discourage the unwarranted or abusive use of the offender
- 8 grievance process, an offender shall be assessed a two-dollar fee for
- 9 each grievance he or she files that is found by the department to be
- 10 without merit, except that no fee shall be assessed for the first two
- 11 grievances filed by an offender that are found to be without merit.
- 12 Fees assessed under this section shall be in addition to any other
- 13 disciplinary action taken by the department in response to an
- 14 offender's unwarranted or abusive use of the grievance process. The
- 15 fees may be deducted from an offender's institution account or, if the
- 16 offender is indigent, recorded as a debt against the account and
- 17 recouped as provided in RCW 72.09.450.
