1 AN ACT Relating to snowmobile registration fees; and amending RCW 2 46.10.040.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.10.040 and 1986 c 16 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

Application for registration shall be made to the department in 6 7 ((such)) the manner and upon ((such)) forms ((as)) the department ((shall)) prescribes, and shall state the name and address of each 8 owner of the snowmobile to be registered, and shall be signed by at 9 10 least one such owner, and shall be accompanied by an annual registration fee to be established by the commission, 11 after consultation with the committee((, at no more than fifteen dollars)) 12 13 and any state-wide snowmobile user groups. However, the fee shall be 14 ((ten)) fifteen dollars pending action by the commission to increase 15 the fee. Any increase in the fee shall not exceed two dollars and 16 fifty cents ((annually)) in any one year, ((up to the registration fee 17 limit of fifteen dollars)) and there shall be an increase of two dollars and fifty cents on September 30, 1996, and another two dollars 18 19 and fifty cents on September 30, 1997, but shall not be increased more

often than every two years thereafter, after consultation with the committee and any state-wide snowmobile user group. Upon receipt of the application and the application fee, ((such)) the snowmobile shall be registered and a registration number assigned, which shall be affixed to the snowmobile in a manner provided in RCW 46.10.070.

6 The registration provided in this section shall be valid for a 7 period of one year. At the end of ((such)) the period of registration, 8 every owner of a snowmobile in this state shall renew his <u>or her</u> 9 registration in ((such)) the manner ((as)) the department ((shall)) 10 prescribes, for an additional period of one year, upon payment of the 11 annual registration fee as determined by the commission.

Any person acquiring a snowmobile already validly registered under the provisions of this chapter must, within ten days of the acquisition or purchase of ((such)) the snowmobile, make application to the department for transfer of ((such)) the registration, and ((such)) the application shall be accompanied by a transfer fee of one dollar.

A snowmobile owned by a resident of another state or Canadian 17 province where registration is not required by law may be issued a 18 19 nonresident registration permit valid for not more than sixty days. 20 Application for ((such a)) the permit shall state the name and address of each owner of the snowmobile to be registered and shall be signed by 21 at least one ((such)) owner and shall be accompanied by a registration 22 23 fee of five dollars. The registration permit shall be carried on the 24 vehicle at all times during its operation in this state.

The registration fees provided in this section shall be in lieu of any personal property or excise tax heretofore imposed on snowmobiles by this state or any political subdivision thereof, and no city, county, or other municipality, and no state agency shall hereafter impose any other registration or license fee on any snowmobile in this state.

The department shall make available a pair of uniform decals consistent with the provisions of RCW 46.10.070. In addition to the registration fee provided ((herein)) in this section the department shall charge each applicant for registration the actual cost of ((said)) the decal. The department shall make available replacement decals for a fee equivalent to the actual cost of the decals.
