- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.79.490 and 1993 c 256 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Every person shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor who:
- 7 (1) For any consideration or gratuity or promise thereof, signs or 8 declines to sign any initiative or referendum petition; or
- 9 (2) Provides or receives consideration for soliciting or procuring 10 signatures on an initiative or referendum petition if any part of the 11 consideration is based upon the number of signatures solicited or 12 procured, or offers to provide or agrees to receive such consideration 13 any of which is based on the number of signatures solicited or
- 14 procured; or
 - 15 (3) Gives or offers any consideration or gratuity to any person to
 - 16 induce him or her to sign or not to sign or to vote for or against any
 - 17 initiative or referendum measure; or
 - 18 (4) Interferes with or attempts to interfere with the right of any 19 voter to sign or not to sign an initiative or referendum petition or

- 1 with the right to vote for or against an initiative or referendum 2 measure by threats, intimidation, or any other corrupt means or 3 practice; or
- 4 (5) Receives, handles, distributes, pays out, or gives away, 5 directly or indirectly, money or any other thing of value contributed by or received from any person, firm, association, or corporation whose 6 7 residence or principal office is, or the majority of whose members or 8 stockholders have their residence outside, the state of Washington, for 9 any service rendered for the purpose of aiding in procuring signatures 10 upon any initiative or referendum petition or for the purpose of aiding in the adoption or rejection of any initiative or referendum measure: 11 PROVIDED, That this subsection shall not apply to or prohibit any 12 13 activity which is properly reported in accordance with the applicable provisions of chapter 42.17 RCW; or 14
- 15 (6) Solicits or procures signatures for an initiative or referendum
 16 petition for consideration without wearing a notice visible to the
 17 public that contains the following statement: "I am a paid signature
 18 gatherer."
- 19 <u>The public disclosure commission must by rule establish standards</u> 20 for the size and design of the notice.
- A gross misdemeanor under this section is punishable to the same 22 extent as a gross misdemeanor that is punishable under RCW 9A.20.021.
