BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:

3 THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state there 4 shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state for their 5 approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to Article VII, 6 section 10 of the Constitution of the state of Washington to read as 7 follows:

8 Article VII, section 10. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 9 7, section 1 (Amendment 14) and Article 7, section 2 (Amendment 17), 10 the following tax exemption shall be allowed as to real property:

the following tax exemption shall be allowed as to real property: 11 The legislature shall have the power, by appropriate legislation, 12 to grant to retired property owners relief from the property tax on the real property occupied as a residence by those owners and to grant to 13 14 property owners relief from the property tax on the real property which is leased as a residence to disabled persons or low-income senior 15 16 citizens. The legislature may place such restrictions and conditions 17 upon the granting of such relief as it shall deem proper. restrictions and conditions may include, but are not limited to, the 18 19 limiting of the relief to those property owners below a specific level 20 of income and those fulfilling certain minimum residential 21 requirements.
