1            AN ACT Relating to superior court judges; and amending RCW  
2 2.08.061.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.08.061 and 1992 c 189 s 1 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6            There shall be in the county of King no more than fifty-eight  
7 judges of the superior court; in the county of Spokane ten judges of  
8 the superior court; and in the county of Pierce nineteen judges of the  
9 superior court. The King county legislative authority may phase in the  
10 additional ((~~twelve~~)) nine judges, as authorized by the 1992 amendments  
11 to this section, over a period of time not to extend beyond July 1,  
12 ((~~1996~~)) 2006. ((~~No more than two of the additional twelve judges may~~  
13 ~~take office prior to July 1, 1993.~~))
