NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Washington State Senate, 4 5 with the House of Representatives concurring, that for the duration of the 1995 second special session of the Legislature, neither house may 6 7 consider any bills, memorials, or joint resolutions except budgets, matters necessary to implement budgets, revenue measures, and matters 8 9 incident to the interim and to the closing of the business of the 1995 second special session of the Legislature, and that after 5:00 p.m. 10 Thursday, May 25th, only matters incident to the interim and to the 11 12 closing of the business of the 1995 second special session of the Legislature may be considered. 13
