1 AN ACT Relating to the revocation of a physician's license; and
2 amending RCW 18.71.019.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.71.019 and 1994 sp.s. c 9 s 305 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 The Uniform Disciplinary Act, chapter 18.130 RCW, governs
7 unlicensed practice and the issuance and denial of licenses and
8 discipline of licensees under this chapter. When a panel of the
9 commission revokes a license, the respondent may request review of the
10 revocation order of the panel by the remaining members of the
11 commission not involved in the initial investigation. The respondent's
12 request for review must be filed within twenty days of the effective
13 date of the order revoking the respondent's license. The review shall
14 be scheduled for hearing by the remaining members of the commission not
15 involved in the initial investigation within sixty days. The
16 commission shall adopt rules establishing review procedures.
