HB 1214-S2 - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/8/95)

Requires sex offenders who are under the jurisdiction of the United States probation service to register.

Requires sex offenders convicted under federal statutes, or the laws of a foreign country, to register.

Requires a registered offender who moves out of state to disclose the new address to the sheriff of the county of most recent registration.

Requires the registration of sex offenders who are acquitted by reason of insanity.

Provides a class C felony offense for failing to register as required.
