Brief Description: Authorizing permanent expulsion for disruptive students.

HB 1292-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/10/95)

Provides that school districts, superintendents, principals, and teachers are not liable for civil damages or criminal penalties resulting from the expulsion of a student, in the absence of an act of malice.

Requires notices to be posted in classrooms.

Requires a conference between a parent and the teacher or principal prior to exclusion of a student.
