Brief Description: Providing for property tax reform based on equity and disclosure.

HB 1688 - DIGEST

Declares an intent to: (1) Affirm the concept of valuing and assessing property at one hundred percent of its true and fair value for the purposes of determining property tax liability;

- (2) strengthen the statutory limitation on property tax rates;
- (3) provide for clarification of billing schedules;
- (4) reduce the burden of proof placed upon property taxpayers when challenging property tax valuations;
- (5) provide for clear communication of the cost of voterapproved property taxes through more detailed information on ballot propositions and on notifications pertaining to property tax assessments; and
- (6) provide for annual revaluation cycles to lessen the impact of property value increases on property tax bills and to promote increased equity among all property taxpayers.
