HB 2158-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/10/96)

Declares that a person is guilty of assault in the first degree if he or she recklessly exposes or transmits to another person the human immunodeficiency virus.

Declares that homicide is the killing of a human being by exposing him or her to the human immunodeficiency virus with death occurring any time after transmission.
