Brief Description: Penalizing disarming a law enforcement officer.

**HB 2178-S - DIGEST**

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 1/22/96)

Provides that disarming a law enforcement officer is a class C felony unless the firearm is discharged when the person removes the firearm, in which case the offense is a class B felony.

Declares that a person who commits another crime while disarming a law enforcement officer may be punished separately for each crime.
