HB 2883-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/6/96)

Provides that, in a county with a population of five hundred thousand or more, the auditor may, in a precinct having fewer than one hundred active registered voters, conduct the voting by mail ballot.

Allows voters to choose to vote in another precinct.
