Brief Description: Revoking the license of a massage practitioner who has been convicted of prostitution.

SB 5556-S - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 3/10/95)

Authorizes the secretary to revoke for eight years the license of a massage practitioner who has been convicted of prostitution. Authorizes the revocation even if the conviction is on appeal. Reinstates the license if the conviction is overturned. Prohibits the issuance of a license to any person convicted of a prostitution offense within the previous eight years.
