Brief Description: Requiring the utilities and transportation commission to review the impact that utility rate increases, merger decisions, and layoffs have on the economy, society, and the quality of utility service provided.

SB 6726 - DIGEST

(SEE ALSO PROPOSED 1ST SUB)

Directs the commission to consider the economic, societal, and quality of utility service impacts to communities, businesses, individuals, and state and local governments prior to approving a merger by a public utility supplier that affects the employment status of one hundred or more employees of the public utility supplier, or a rate increase or rate decrease that is the result of a work force reduction by a public utility supplier that affects one hundred or more employees of the public utility supplier.

Authorizes the commission to modify or reject all or part of a merger, rate increase, or rate decrease proposed by a public utility supplier based upon a finding of significant economic, societal, or quality of utility service impact.
