3 On page 15, after line 11 of the striking amendment, insert the
4 following:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 206.** A new section is added to chapter 67.70
6 RCW to read as follows:

7 The lottery commission shall conduct games with themes related to
8 professional minor league sports in the state. These games are in
9 addition to any games conducted under RCW 67.70.042 and are intended to
10 generate additional moneys sufficient to cover the distributions under
11 RCW 67.70.240(6). No game may be conducted under this section before
12 January 1, 1998. No game is required to be conducted under this
13 section after December 31, 2018.

14 For purposes of this section, professional minor league sports-
15 means a team that is not a member of the national football league,
16 major league baseball, the national basketball association, the
17 national hockey league, the major soccer league, or the major indoor
18 soccer league and plays its home games within the boundaries of the
19 state of Washington.-

20 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct internal
21 references accordingly, and correct the title of the bill.

22 On page 16, after line 6 of the striking amendment, insert the
23 following:

24 (6) For distribution to the professional minor league stadium
25 account created in section 218 of this act. Distributions to the
26 account created in section 218 of this act shall be limited to the
27 actual amount generated from lottery sales authorized under section 210
28 of this act, minus amounts authorized under subsections (1), (2), (7)
29 and (8) of this section. Distributions under this subsection shall
30 cease after December 31, 2018;-

31 Renumber the remaining subsection consecutively and correct internal
32 references accordingly.

1 On page 21, after line 13 of the striking amendment, insert the
2 following:

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 214.** (1) The professional minor league
4 stadium account is created in the custody of the state treasurer.
5 Distributions under RCW 67.70.240(6) shall be deposited into the
6 account. Only the director of the department of community, trade, and
7 economic development or the director's designee may authorize
8 expenditures from the account. The account is subject to allotment
9 procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not
10 required for expenditures.

11 (2) Expenditures from the professional minor league stadium
12 account may be used only for purposes of grants to cities and counties
13 for professional minor league sports stadiums. The minor league
14 stadium grants may be used to acquire, construct, own, remodel,
15 maintain, equip, reequip, repair, and operate a stadium to be used for
16 professional minor league sports as defined in section 210 of this act.

17 (3) Cities and counties must submit proposals for grants from the
18 account. To the extent funds are available, cities and counties must
19 meet eligibility criteria as established by the director of the
20 department of community, trade, and economic development. The grants
21 shall be awarded on a competitive basis and can be awarded on a multi-
22 year basis not to exceed a ten-year period.-

23 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct internal
24 references, and correct the title of the bill.

EFFECT: Creates a new minor league sports lottery. Revenue
limited to actual amounts generated. Moneys used to fund minor
league sports stadiums on a statewide competitive basis. Allows
up to a 10-year commitment to fund a specific project.
