8 (2) The following are eligible for grant funds on a matching 9 basis under this program: state agencies, political subdivisions of the 10 state, and nonprofit organizations, including but not limited to 11 bicycling groups and community and civic organizations. All entities 12 receiving matching funds must provide a regularly scheduled program 13 complying with standards established by the commission.-

On page 5, line 31, after section 4-, strike (2) and (3)-.

EFFECT: Expands and clarifies the organizations eligible grant funding under this act. Allows the Traffic Safety Commission to expend funds to provide safety equipment and supplies and provide other support for bicycle and pedestrian safety programs.
