- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The governor's juvenile justice advisory committee shall conduct a study of juvenile detention standards. The study shall:
 - (1) Include a survey of standards in place and proposed for all existing and planned detention facilities in this state;
 - (2) Document current compliance of detention standards with recommended American correctional association standards and those delineated in RCW 13.06.050;
- 12 (3) Document any concerns, problems, or issues regarding current 13 standards that have a direct impact on the safety and health of 14 offenders, staff, and the community;
- 15 (4) Make recommendations as to improvements needed and a timeline 16 for the implementation of such improvements;
- 17 (5) Recommend a schedule of periodic review of juvenile detention 18 standards;
 - (6) Conduct an analysis of the costs to implement the recommendations in accordance with the recommended timeline; and
- 21 (7) Submit a report to the legislature and governor by December 22 31, 1998.—
- 23 Correct the title.

<u>EFFECT:</u> Requires the governor's juvenile justice advisory committee to conduct a study of juvenile detention standards and make recommendations to the legislature.
