- 7 "We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of 8 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully 9 represent and petition as follows:
- WHEREAS, The Bonneville Power Administration was initially created 10 11 to provide low-cost power to rural areas, a tradition that it maintains 12 today; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Bonneville Power Administration currently markets power generated by twenty-nine federal dams; and 14
- 15 WHEREAS, The Pacific Northwest enjoys low electricity rates, thanks 16 largely to the Bonneville Power Administration and the power generated 17 by the federal dams; and
- WHEREAS, Those rates would be seriously jeopardized by the sale of 18 the Bonneville Power Administration and the sale of the federal dams or 19 20 the right to market the power generated by those dams; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The sale of the Bonneville Power Administration and the 22 sale of the federal dams or the right to market the power generated by those dams would threaten the long-standing relationship the Bonneville 23 24 Power Administration has established with the Northwest's public 25 utility districts and rural electric associations; and
- 26 WHEREAS, The Bonneville Power Administration currently contributes a portion of its revenue to salmon restoration, and there is no 27 quarantee those funds would be available if the Bonneville Power 28 29 Administration is sold;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the 30 31 President and Congress agree not to sell the Bonneville Power Administration or the federal dams or the right to market the power 32 33 generated by those dams, and to allow the Bonneville Administration to continue fulfilling its mission of providing low-cost 34 35 power to the Pacific Northwest.
- 36 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately transmitted to the Honorable William J. Clinton, President of the 37

- 1 United States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker
- 2 of the House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the
- 3 State of Washington."
