If the voters do not adopt and ratify 9 this act, except for this section and sections 401 and 506 of this act, 10 at the next general election, section 506 of this act takes effect 11 January 1, 1998. If the voters do adopt and ratify this act, except 12 for this section and sections 401 and 506 of this act, section 506 of 13 this act is null and void.

14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 506.** On each June 30th following the effective 15 date of this act, the state treasurer shall deposit one hundred ten 16 million dollars from the general fund into the permanent common school 17 fund. This transfer is exempt from the provisions of RCW 18 43.135.035(4)."

19 Correct the title accordingly.

20 <u>EFFECT:</u> If the voters reject the property tax reductions provided 21 in SB 5835, an equivalent amount of revenues will be deposited annually 22 into the Permanent Common School Fund. The Permanent Fund is a trust 23 fund created in the State's Constitution. The interest on this fund is 24 dedicated to financing the construction and remodeling of K-12 schools. 25 This amendment will not impact the I-601 spending limit.
