The primary purpose of the trust is to pledge state-wide available college student assistance to needy or disadvantaged 11 students, especially middle and high school youth, considered at-risk 12 13 of dropping out of secondary education who participate in boardapproved early awareness and outreach programs and who enter any 14 15 accredited Washington institution of postsecondary education within two years of high school graduation. 16

The board shall deposit refunds and recoveries of student financial aid funds expended in <u>the</u> prior ((biennia)) <u>fiscal period</u> in such account. The board may also deposit moneys that have been contributed from other state, federal, or private sources.

21 Expenditures from the fund shall be for financial aid to needy or disadvantaged students. The board may annually expend such sums from 22 the fund as may be necessary to fulfill the purposes of this section, 23 24 including not more than three percent for the costs to administer aid programs supported by the fund. All earnings of investments of 25 balances in the state educational trust fund shall be credited to the 26 Expenditures from the fund shall not be subject to 27 trust fund. appropriation but are subject to allotment procedures under chapter 28 29 43.88 RCW."
