This part of the report shall describe: (i) the amount of electricity saved by such conservation programs; (ii) the 18 overhead costs to the municipal electric utility to administer such 19 20 programs, including but not limited to amounts expended by other 21 municipal departments and nonprofit entities in administering such 22 and (iii) for low-income weatherization programs, the programs; 23 overhead cost per unit weatherized as compared to the overhead costs of 24 comparable programs administered by the state. "
