For the purposes of this subsection (2)(e), 17 it is not a violation of this section for a quest editorial or column 18 by an elected official to argue for or against the proposition or to 19 20 urge voters to vote for or against it. Nothing in this subsection authorizes any person who has filed a declaration of candidacy to seek 21 or make use of the facilities of an agency for preparation and delivery 22 23 of a quest editorial or column"
