**Background:** Congress repealed the Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) program and replaced it with the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program as part of federal welfare reform.

**Summary of Bill:** References to the AFDC program in the Revised Code of Washington are deleted and replaced with references to the TANF program.
