These subjects include (1) employment; (2) bank and saving account and insurance policies 3) creditors 4) sources of compensation (4) corporations artnerships, so exproprietors hipsi, ons and otherentities on whom compensation considerations paidorgiven any office as held prownership interest 10 percent for was held; (6) real property wined in Washington State; (7) events where food and beverages were provided nexcess of \$50; and (8) where payments were made of reasonable xpenses associated it happearance in an official pacity, including xpenses related oattending eminars and educational programs.

Incertainstances uch matter must be reported nly if the value exceeds a specific and ount. The reporting a value for these items is done using ranges of dollar alues rather than specific ollar mounts.

## SUMMARY:

Beginning ith calendar earl 996, the public employer of any person required of ile statement of financial fairs that he public is closur of must file disclosur of reasonable xpenses it authorized of ficiend of fiction accept for appearing in an officiend pacity, not undirect tendance to seminars and educational programs.

The offician office would not have to report he seitems.
