## **BACKGROUND:**

UnderArtic Nat Sections of the Washington State Constitution the Legislaturest provide for the uniformelection of country official This constitution equirement does not apply however, if a country has adopted its with home rule tharters, long as the country continues a bide by the state 's onstitution dependent and provide for the election certain lasses from the sount population of provide powers and duties ftwo or more country officials.

The Legislatuhræsamended thelawsgoverningheelection fountyofficial wice to exempt certain ounties from the uniform election equirement In 1990, the Legislature lowedary noncharter ounty with a population 300,000 or more to increase the legislation from the fivenembers. In 1996, the Legislature authorized he legislation from the county with a population 250,000 or more to appoint a county coroner.

## SUMMARY:

The authority f certain ounties to appoint county of ficials increased. The legislatize thority fany county that has a population of 200,000 or more may adopt a resolution or dinance pointing county auditor.

The county's egislation throat adopt the resolution ordinance pointing a county auditor tleas 80 days before the first ay offiling orther imarglection for county offices. If the resolution ordinance adopted it must be confirmed or rejected by the county's oters at the next special election the date of the special election ust be more than 45 days from the date the resolution ordinance adopted. If the resolution ordinance approved by a majority of an election ill not be held for the position of county auditornless another esolution ordinance reinstatiangelections approved by the voters of the county.
