BACKGROUND:

Informationeld by a publicagency is generally ubject to public disclosure. Numerous exemptions to the public disclosure quirementare codific instatute. Some of these exemptions relate or ecords containing ersonal information of proprietaby siness information State and local gencies are required to make records to tinclude within statutor exemption vailab Ferpublic inspection of copying.

Summary ofBill:

A new exemption for computer software is added to the public disclosure requirements intensection pecifies hence exemption is designed opposed taxpayer investments in software development and to encourage public private cooperation it threspects software development.

Computer softwareowned by stateand local gencies is exempt from public inspection copying. The exemption applies computers of tware (a) wholly owned by a state or local gency; and (b) owned by a state or local gency in conjunction that privatentity.

Forpurposesoftheexemption; computers of tware is defined as the programming source code or object code necessary for the operation of a computer program. Records accessible through the computer program are not included within the exemption are subject opublications unambles so there is exempt.
