## SB 5253

### C 395 L 97

Synopsis as Enacted

**Brief Description:** Allowing nonresidents under the age of fifteen to obtain a free fishing license.

Sponsors: Senators Strannigan, Oke, Hargrove, Roach, Morton, Swecker, Horn and Winsley.

#### Senate Committee on Natural Resources & Parks House Committee on Natural Resources

**Background:** Current law requires nonresident youths under 15 years of age to pay \$20 for a fishing license for game fish. Resident youths under 15 years of age are not required to have a fishing license.

**Summary:** A fishing license is not required for resident or nonresident juveniles under 15 years of age. Nonresident juveniles under 15 years of age must be accompanied by an adult, with a valid Washington fishing license, to qualify for exemption from the \$20 nonresident fishing license fee.
