**Background:** Initiative Measure No. 134, passed by voters on November 3, 1992, places a number of limitations on political contributions, including an interval before and after legislative sessions in which no contributions can be accepted.

**Summary of Bill:** Campaign contribution limitations are amended to provide that a contribution may be accepted if it is received by mail and postmarked before the proscribed time period.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
