1 AN ACT Relating to taxation of dental appliances, devices,
2 restorations, and substitutes; amending RCW 82.04.120, 82.08.0283, and
3 82.12.0277; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.04.120 and 1989 c 302 s 201 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 "To manufacture" embraces all activities of a commercial or
8 industrial nature wherein labor or skill is applied, by hand or
9 machinery, to materials so that as a result thereof a new, different or
10 useful substance or article of tangible personal property is produced
11 for sale or commercial or industrial use, and shall include: (1) The
12 production or fabrication of special made or custom made articles; and
13 (2) the production or fabrication of dental appliances, devices,
14 restorations, substitutes, or other dental laboratory products by a
15 dental laboratory or dental technician.

16 "To manufacture" shall not include conditioning of seed for use in
17 planting or activities which consist of cutting, grading, or ice
18 glazing seafood which has been cooked, frozen or canned outside this
19 state.

1 **Sec. 2.** RCW 82.08.0283 and 1996 c 162 s 1 are each amended to read
2 as follows:

3 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of
4 insulin; prosthetic ((and)) devices and the components thereof; dental
5 appliances, devices, restorations, and substitutes, and the components
6 thereof, including but not limited to full and partial dentures,
7 crowns, inlays, fillings, braces, and retainers; orthotic devices
8 prescribed for an individual by a person licensed under chapters 18.25,
9 18.57, or 18.71 RCW ((or)); hearing instruments dispensed or fitted by
10 a person licensed under chapter 18.35 RCW, and the components thereof;
11 medicines of mineral, animal, and botanical origin prescribed,
12 administered, dispensed, or used in the treatment of an individual by
13 a person licensed under chapter 18.36A RCW; ostomic items; and
14 medically prescribed oxygen. For the purposes of this section,
15 "medically prescribed oxygen" includes, but is not limited to, sale or
16 rental of oxygen concentrator systems, oxygen enricher systems, liquid
17 oxygen systems, and gaseous, bottled oxygen systems to an individual
18 under a prescription issued by a person licensed under chapter 18.57 or
19 18.71 RCW for use in the medical treatment of that individual. In
20 addition, the tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of
21 repair services for any of the items exempted under this section.

22 **Sec. 3.** RCW 82.12.0277 and 1996 c 162 s 2 are each amended to read
23 as follows:

24 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the
25 use of insulin; prosthetic ((and)) devices and the components thereof;
26 dental appliances, devices, restorations, and substitutes, and the
27 components thereof, including but not limited to full and partial
28 dentures, crowns, inlays, fillings, braces, and retainers; orthotic
29 devices prescribed for an individual by a person licensed under
30 chapters 18.25, 18.57, or 18.71 RCW ((or)); hearing instruments
31 dispensed or fitted by a person licensed under chapter 18.35 RCW, and
32 the components thereof; medicines of mineral, animal, and botanical
33 origin prescribed, administered, dispensed, or used in the treatment of
34 an individual by a person licensed under chapter 18.36A RCW; ostomic
35 items; and medically prescribed oxygen. For the purposes of this
36 section, "medically prescribed oxygen" includes, but is not limited to,
37 sale or rental of oxygen concentrator systems, oxygen enricher systems,
38 liquid oxygen systems, and gaseous, bottled oxygen systems to an

1 individual under a prescription issued by a person licensed under
2 chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW for use in the medical treatment of that
3 individual.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
5 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
6 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
7 July 1, 1997.
