- 1 AN ACT Relating to metal detectors in state parks; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 43.51 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. It is the intent of the legislature that
- 5 those significant historic archaeological resources on state park lands
- 6 that are of importance to the history of our state, or its communities,
- 7 be protected for the people of the state. At the same time, the
- 8 legislature also recognizes that the recreational use of metal
- 9 detectors in state parks is a legitimate form of recreation that can be
- 10 compatible with the protection of significant historic archaeological
- 11 resources. It is, therefore, the intent of the legislature to allow
- 12 the recreational use of metal detectors in state parks except in areas
- 13 where significant historic archaeological resources have been
- 14 identified.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.51 RCW
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 The commission may not prohibit the use of metal detectors for
- 18 recreational purposes in state parks except in areas where a historic

been identified pursuant to RCW archaeological resource has 1 2 27.53.030(11). In those state park areas that do not contain 3 significant historic archaeological resources under RCW 27.53.030(11), 4 the use of metal detectors shall be permitted subject to reasonable rules set forth by the commission. The commission shall annually 5 review its list of parks in which the use of metal detectors is allowed 6 and shall include any additional park areas that have been verified as 8 not having significant historic archaeological resources.
