- 1 AN ACT Relating to the state fossil; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 1.20 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes that the large,
- 5 hairy prehistoric elephants of the extinct genus Mammuthus roamed the
- 6 north American continent, including the Pacific Northwest, during the
- 7 Pleistocene epoch (Ice Ages).
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 The imperial woolly mammoth of North America, Mammuthus
- 11 primigenius, is hereby designated as the official fossil of the state
- 12 of Washington.
