- 1 AN ACT Relating to arming community corrections officers; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 72.02 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.02 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Community corrections officers may, at their discretion, carry
- 7 firearms during the course of their official field duties. The
- 8 department shall not be responsible for providing or paying for any
- 9 firearms, materials, equipment, or training associated with
- 10 implementation of this policy. A community corrections officer who
- 11 chooses to be armed pursuant to this section shall, at his or her own
- 12 expense, arrange for and complete any necessary training. In addition,
- 13 a community corrections officer who chooses to be armed pursuant to
- 14 this section shall, at his or her own expense, provide his or her own
- 15 firearm as well as any associated materials and equipment needed by the
- 16 community corrections officer in order to carry a firearm.

(2) Nothing in this section may be construed as making community corrections officers eligible for membership in the law enforcement officers' and fire fighters' retirement system under chapter 41.26 RCW.
