- 1 AN ACT Relating to senate confirmation of gubernatorial appointees;
- 2 and amending RCW 43.06.092.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.06.092 and 1981 c 338 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Any gubernatorial appointee subject to senate confirmation
- 7 shall continue to serve <u>only until rejected by a vote of the senate or</u>
- 8 until the conclusion of the next regularly scheduled legislative
- 9 <u>session after his or her appointment</u> unless ((rejected)) <u>confirmed</u> by
- 10 a vote of the senate. An appointee who is rejected by a vote of the
- 11 senate shall not be reappointed to the same position for a period of
- 12 one year from termination of service.
- 13 (2) Any person appointed by the governor to fill the unexpired term
- 14 of an appointment subject to senate confirmation must also be confirmed
- 15 by the senate.
