1 AN ACT Relating to the state insect; adding a new section to 2 chapter 1.20 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the common green darner dragonfly, Anax junius Drury, can be found throughout Washington and is easily recognizable by its bright green head and thorax. The legislature further recognizes that the common green darner dragonfly, also known as the "mosquito hawk," is a beneficial contributor to our ecosystem.

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW 11 to read as follows:

12 The common green darner dragonfly, Anax junius Drury, is hereby 13 designated as the official insect of the state of Washington.
