- 1 AN ACT Relating to commercial telephone solicitation; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 19.158 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 80.36
- 3 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that, despite efforts
- 6 to regulate commercial telephone solicitation, this practice continues
- 7 to annoy and frustrate many citizens. The legislature further finds
- 8 that a system of identification in telephone directories of those
- 9 citizens who do not wish to be solicited by telephone would help to
- 10 eliminate unwanted calls.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 19.158 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 A commercial telephone solicitor is in violation of this chapter if
- 14 he or she engages in the telephone solicitation of a person who is
- 15 identified, in a published telephone directory available for general
- 16 use, as a person who does not wish to receive any telephone
- 17 solicitation.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 80.36 RCW to read as follows:
- 3 (1) The commission shall require telecommunications companies to 4 provide for identification in a telephone directory of persons who do 5 not wish to receive telephone solicitations.
- 6 (2) The commission shall by rule ensure that telecommunications
 7 companies inform their residential customers of the provisions of this
 8 act. The notification may be made by (a) annual inserts in the billing
 9 statements mailed to residential customers, or (b) conspicuous
 10 publication of the notice in the consumer information pages of local
 11 telephone directories.
