1 AN ACT Relating to the penalty for third degree theft; amending RCW 2 9A.56.050; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.56.050 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 260 s 9A.56.050 are 5 each amended to read as follows:

6 (1) A person is guilty of theft in the third degree if he commits 7 theft of property or services which does not exceed two hundred and 8 fifty dollars in value.

9 (2) Theft in the third degree is a gross misdemeanor. <u>Upon a third</u> 10 <u>conviction within five years, the court shall impose a minimum sentence</u> 11 <u>of sixty days in jail.</u>
